

Five New Chavurot Formed at Anshai Torah

Future activities include The King and I, a fund raiser for Chai House, dinner out, walking Shabbat followed by a pot luck dinner, wine tasting, attending the play: Technicolor Dreamcoat, BBQ and fireworks, Shabbat Services followed by pot luck Shabbat dinner, Dinner in the Sukkah, Chanukah Parties and much more.

Individual Chavurot plan their own activities varying between Jewish observance or celebration and purely social ones.

Some of the Chavurot have room to expand while others are at their max. But a new round of applications are being accepted as the committee hopes to organize additional Chavurot.
