The religious school year comes to a close in May with three important events.

Shabbat School is on Shabbat, May 11, 9:30am. Parents can spend time with their children in grade-level services, followed by a Learners' Service with Rabbi Kushnick, or they can participate in the main service. Everyone will unite for Kiddush and lunch at 12:15 pm.

On Friday, May 17, Graduating High School seniors will be honored at Shabbat services for their achievements, followed by dinner and a guest speaker. Every graduating student will have an opportunity to speak as well.
